1. Give each student a piece of **white paper**.





- 3. Instruct students to follow along with you as you draw the toucan on the board, or play the draw along video that accompanies the lesson.
- 4. Draw the toucan with the students using the "Toucan Drawing Guide" on the next page. It doesn't have to look just like the example.
- 5. They may use the back of their paper to re-draw their toucan if they choose. No new papers should be handed out. Students need to work with their "mistakes."
- 6. Color with crayons, markers or colored pencils.
- 7. Instructions for art (take home, portfolio, etc.)









Draw a long vertical line near the center of the paper. Add a curved line to make a letter "D"




Add an eye. Draw a curved line on one side of the "D" for a belly and one on the other for a wing. Add curved feathers.




Next, add a branch for the toucan to sit on. It's okay if the lines curve a bit.



Draw a long, curved beak from the straight side of the "D". Add a line in the center and a few inside the beak.




Finish off the toucan with some tai



As a final touch, add leaves to fill in the empty space in the background. They can be pointed or curved.

Hope you enjoy your Snow Day Art Lessons and see you soon,


