The Akin Memorial Scholarship \$500

The goal of the Akin Memorial Scholarships is to establish a living memorial for Effie Drennan Akin (1885-1972) and Anita Scott Akin (1917-1994). Effie Akin was a 1905 graduate of Corning High School and then continued to pursue her interest in music at Oberlin College. A lifelong resident of Corning, Iowa, Effie was an active supporter of local cultural and civic events.

Anita Scott Akin was also a lifetime resident of Corning, Iowa. She graduated from Corning High School in 1932. Anita is an alumnus of the University of Iowa, where she obtained a degree in Education. Anita was a teacher at Corning High School for many years teaching both English and drama. Anita was also active in local cultural and civic events.

This \$500 scholarship will be awarded each year to a graduating senior of Southwest Valley High School previously known as Corning High School, and will be selected by a faculty representative and/or a representative of the Akin family. Selection for this scholarship will be based on demonstrating an interest and intended major in education or the field of fine arts, such as speech, art drama, literature, graphic design, music, etc.

A letter acts as the application. The letter should include future plans, an outline of activities and interests in high school, along with a statement of the student's qualifications for this scholarship.

The application should be submitted to the School Counselor's office by April 4th. This scholarship award will be given upon satisfactory completion of the first term of college and indication of enrollment for the second term.
