The Parent in Heaven (PH) Balance Scholarship

The PH Balance Scholarship is intended for a high school senior who, at any time in his/her life, has lost a parent or legal guardian and forever feels that void. As educators and people who have worked in some capacity with children in the schools, we know the importance of family and parents. When the unspeakable happens, we want students to know that we understand and wish to bring some balance into his/her life in the form of a scholarship.

Our \$1,000 scholarship will be presented during the May 2025 District meetings. The students will be selected from schools within IRSPA Districts One, Two and Six. Qualifying students <u>living</u> or going to high school in those counties may apply for the scholarship.

Qualifying students may plan on attending a four-year college, a community college, or a technical school with plans to earn a degree or diploma for their desired field of study. The scholarship is payable to the school after the successful completion of the first semester and continued enrollment for the second semester. Applications may be obtained by contacting an IRSPA District Coordinator, Scholarship Chair of IRSPA (Jean Hoffman), or by going to irspa.org, About tab, scholarship.

NOTE: Fill out the document and save to your drive, documents, or cloud and then create a new email and attach the application as well as the other required documents in pdf format and send to phbalance2021@gmail.com. Put all attachments in **one** email.

Application deadline is April 1 of your senior year.

Include the following documents with the application cover sheet on the next page in the following order:

- 1. Application cover sheet
- 2. Qualifying letter: a letter or document of proof that a parent or legal guardian has passed away.
- 3. A copy of your high school transcripts:
- 4. A 200 word essay explaining what this would mean to you as a child who has lost a parent and how this scholarship will help in achieving your life goals.
- 5. Reference letters: Include three (3) letters of references from three (3) of the following varied categories: teacher, community member, employer, a faith related leader, an extra-curricular coach, a school administrator, an adult sponsor of a club or organization outside of school.
- 6. Have all documents in **pdf format** and email them in **one** email to phbalance2021@gmail.com by **April 1 of your senior year.**
