### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

Please attach a one-page typed essay stating educational plans, aspirations, and one teacher that made a difference in your life. All must be submitted to Southwest Valley High School Counselor by April 1<sup>st</sup>.

### **SELECTION COMMITTEE**

The recipient of this scholarship will be selected by Matt and Annie Miller. The recipient will be announced at the scholarship award ceremony.

### **PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP**

Partial payment of \$1000 will be given after the first day of first semester classes. Remaining payment of the scholarship will be issued after the student completes the first term of college and submits a copy of his or her grades to SWV High School Counselor. No minimum GPA required.
