## Villisca Interchurch Council Technical Scholarships

"Technical Scholarship" means all careers <u>not requiring a four-year</u> <u>degree.</u>

## Guidelines for receiving a scholarship:

- 1. The student must be a graduating student from the Southwest Valley High School.
- 2. The student must not be planning to enroll in a program requiring a <u>four-year degree</u>.
- 3. Grades or class rankings are not considered when selecting the recipients—all students that meet numbers 1 & 2 guidelines above are eligible.
- 4. Students' essays should tell in <u>what</u> career field they plan to get their training, <u>where</u> they plan to get this training, <u>why</u> they chose this career, and/or other things of interest that many help the selection committee.
- 5. Financial need may be a small consideration by the committee, but very seldom is it a deciding factor.
- 6. Those who receive scholarships must provide college transcripts of first term and proof of college enrollment acceptance for second term to redeem their scholarship.
- 7. All students are considered equal. The Villisca Interchurch Council provides these scholarships as our Churches outreach program. Therefore, church affiliations or attendance will not have an impact on the selection process.

Applications will be due to the Southwest Valley School Counselor by March 20<sup>th</sup>.
