LINDA MILLER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

2-\$1000

(One-Nursing and One-Technical Education)

A scholarship in recognition of Linda Jeanne Miller is being established for the first time for the graduating class of 2021. The scholarship will be in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) each year for five consecutive years (2021-2025). The intent of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance for one graduate of Southwest Valley High School to acquire training and/or education in nursing and one SWV graduate to acquire training in technical education.

Linda was a graduate of Corning High School's class of 1961. During her lifetime, Linda Miller was a contributor to many charities, and at her passing the Corning Education Foundation was notified that as a beneficiary of her trust, funds were given to distribute scholarships in nursing and technical education.

Eligibility:

- Any senior who is involved with school activities and who assists with his/her own expenses.
- Financial need is a major criterion for this award.
- Plans to major in nursing or technical education.
- Must have a high school grade point average of 2.5 or higher.
- Plans to attend any type of postsecondary school (4-year college, 2-year college or vocational or technical institute).

Application Procedure: The application should be in the form of a letter and attached resume.

- Include major interests in school.
- Include a statement of future plans/goals for college/training and beyond, explaining how this scholarship will help with attaining those goals.

Selection Committee:

The Corning Education Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee will choose the recipient/s of this scholarship

Disbursement: Payment of the award will be made after the student completes the first term of college and submits a copy of grades to the SWV guidance counselor by the deadline date. If the student has maintained a 2.0 GPA in at least 12 credit hours and is enrolled in at least 12 credit hours for the second term, the counselor will authorize the Corning Education Foundation to make the payment.
